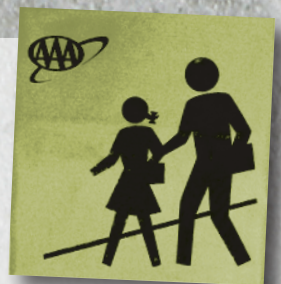

## APPLICATION/ MEMBERSHIP CARD

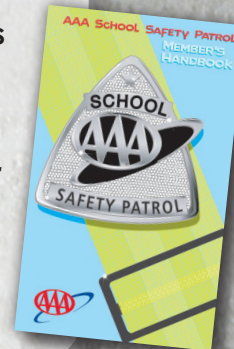

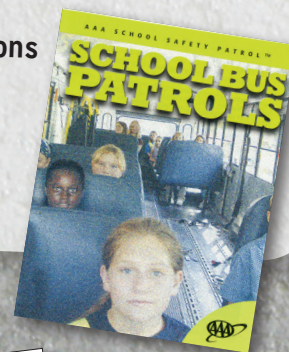

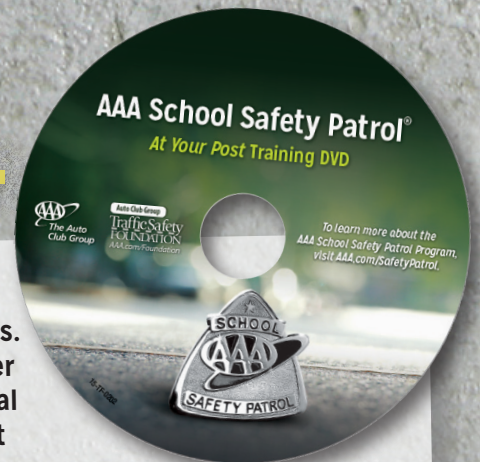


# - TRAINING -
